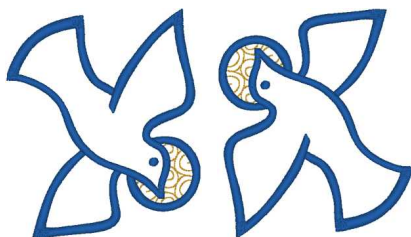

## *Junmo's Reflection:*

Hello my dear friends in the same faith,

My family and I came back to Sydney after a three week holiday in South Korea. Recently it snowed a lot in Korea and the temperature in Seoul is -17.

During my stay in Korea, I visited several Korean churches as well as beautiful places for sightseeing. The 100<sup>th</sup> Memorial Church of Mission in Korea was filled with people, so that I couldn't be in the main building, even though I arrived there 10 minutes before the service. Meanwhile, at a church in the south from Seoul, there were just about ten attendants including alcoholics and homeless. One of my friends has worked for that church for 10 years.

The most impressive church for me was a church for disabled people on the outskirts of Seoul. A female minister started it and has worked for the church till now. She was my best friend's wife who was a church minister. When her husband passed away several years ago she did not know about her future. At the time she never thought about doing ministry by herself. My family and I visited her house and watched a video clip of what they did. Disabled people practising and learning to play musical instruments, including guitar, drum, and keyboard. They led the hymn singing in front of the whole church. It was beautiful and touching to see. I realized again that God works in many different ways.

On the plane back to Sydney, I thought about the future of our church. I thought of it as a place of singing and praying to God's glory; I thought of it as a gathering place for many kinds of Christians and for love-flooding; I thought of it as a place for meeting God's people and experiencing God's presence. God works in us. I look forward to seeing how God will work in me and our church, this year.

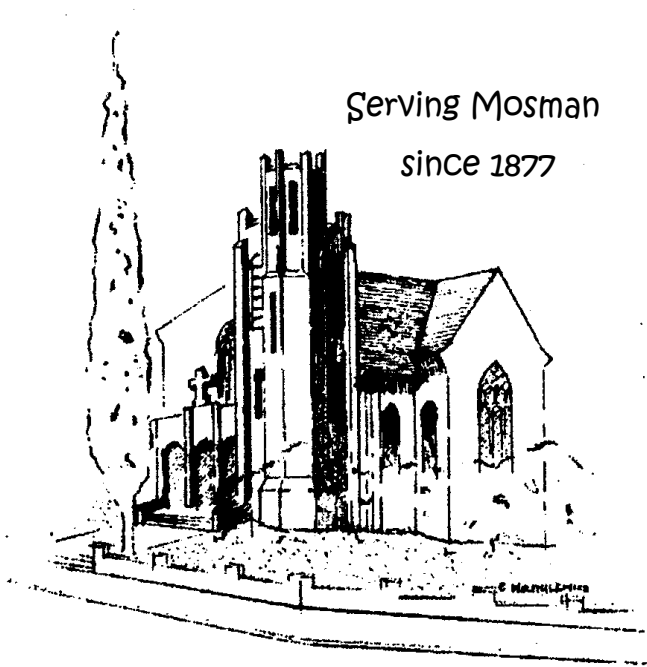
