Sending John Garrett into the arms of God

Last Friday night I got a call from David Garrett. He told me Dr. Rev. John Garrett passed away. My family and I were eating dinner. Telling the news, my children were surprised because when they visited John with me and my wife in the hospital the previous day he was recovering and was expected to get well. John was happy with our visit and asked my children about their classes and how they were doing.

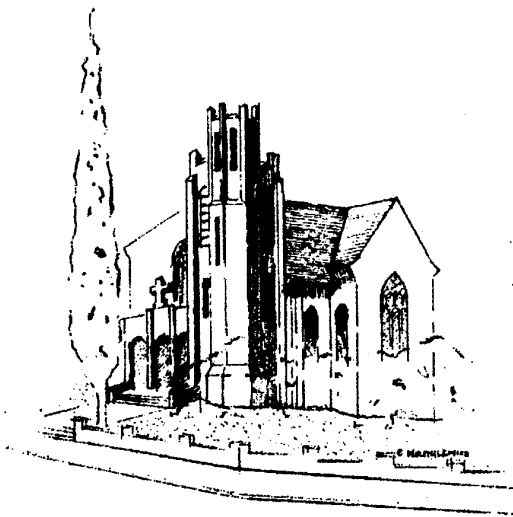
Kyounghee and I didn't know what to say. We recalled the moments we saw him: first in the church; and then the last time in the hospital. As many of you know, Dr. Rev. John Garrett has been regarded as a legend in the mission field in the Pacific islands. Compared with his magnificent career as a theologian and missionary he was an incredibly humble man. He was a magnificent pastoral carer who looked after those around him with prayers, encouragement and love. He was a great biblical scholar and right up to the last he was questioning and challenging the accuracy of some of the English translations in the Bible.

Mosman Uniting Church and I were very lucky and blessed to have Dr. Rev. John Garrett in the midst of us. We remember in our hearts his eyes, which were bright and pure, and his smiles, which were warm and merciful. He went back into the arms of God. We express our deepest condolences to his loving family.
