On the 20th of November, we will participate in NCLS (National Church Life Survey). Many of us know what it is because we have done it before. Just like the Census, it is carried out every 5 years and we are supposed to answer many questions. It will help us to know about our church and its congregations and it will be essential material to help us to plan directions for the future.

As you know I have been teaching scripture classes at Mosman Primary and Mosman High. Sometimes I don't know how much they understand me or how much they like the classes. 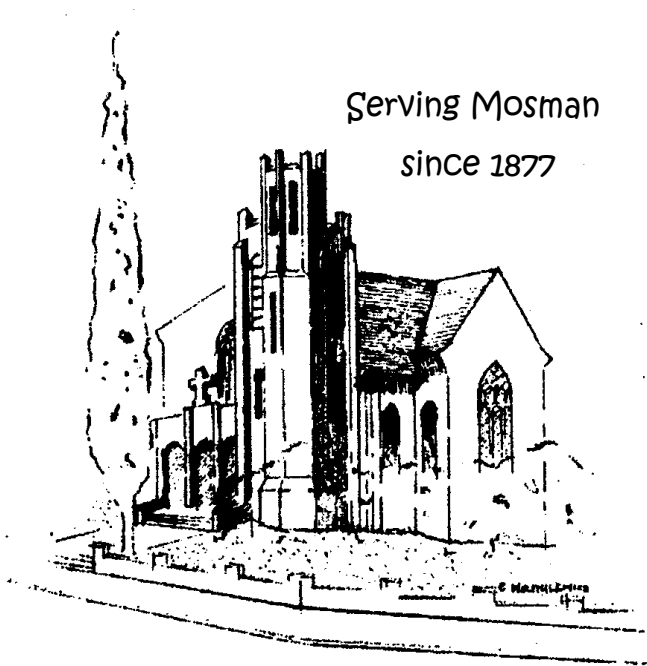
